

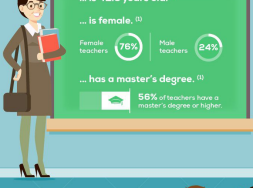


AMERICA'S TYPICAL TEACHER

... is underpaid. ⁽⁴⁾



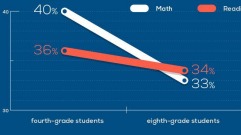
... is close to retirement. ⁽⁴⁾

... faces low achievement numbers from students. ⁽⁵⁾



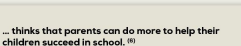
Out of 34 countries, the U.S. ranks:
